Address stream bank instability and arrest bank loss into the Te Onetea stream.

This project aims to address stream bank instability and arrest bank loss into the Te Onetea stream, exclude stock from the riparian zone through the construction of new project fencing and establishment of a 10m wide planting zone inclusive of a mix of native plants and exotic willow clones.

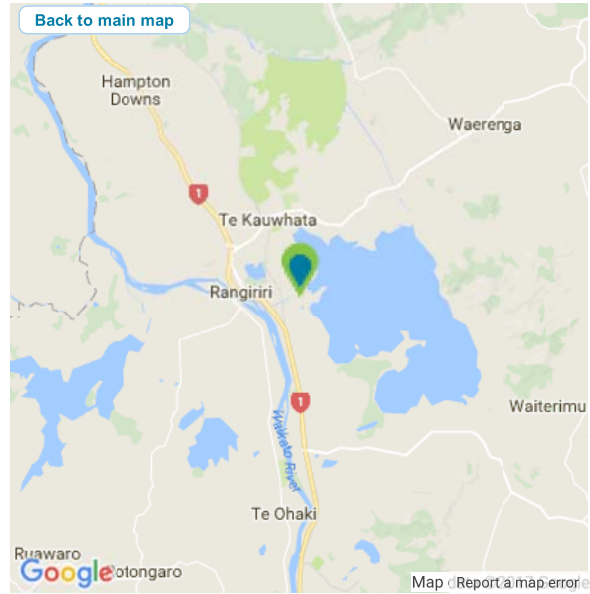
The proposed project covers a total area of 1.79ha or 1560m of stream bank and is located within a parcel of unformed paper road administered by the Waikato District Council, and adjoins Lake Waikare Waikato Tainui 2010 settlement lands.

Waikato RiverCare Inc. has worked closely with Waikato District Council staff, Waikato Regional Council staff and adjoining landowners to develop a project plan.

Key project goals include mechanical weed tree management, vegetation management of desirable specimen trees, stock exclusion from the riparian zone throughout the projects length, use of willow clones to armour erodible banks and the establishment of a 10m wide planting. The planting will also provide a vegetated corridor between the Waikato River and Lake Waikare plus an additional 1.5ha of indigenous vegetation.
