## Minute from the Hearing Panel – regarding:

Miraka Limited's (Miraka) Block 3 rebuttal evidence.

Opportunity for parties to address the Memorandum from Miraka's legal counsel - that the evidence is rebuttal evidence, or why leave should be granted to file the evidence as late primary evidence if the Panel does not accept the evidence as rebuttal.

The Hearing Panel (Panel) issued a Minute (dated 25 July 2019) titled:

## Miraka Limited's (Miraka) Block 3 rebuttal evidence.

It set out that Miraka had lodged three rebuttal statements of evidence (from Mr Jackson, Ms Addenbrooke and Ms Hardy), and that the Panel questioned whether this evidence was in fact rebuttal.

Miraka's legal counsel has filed a memorandum (dated 30 July 2019) setting out why they consider the evidence to be rebuttal; but if the Panel does not accept this, has sought leave for that evidence to be accepted a late primary evidence.

The Panel's minute set out that "If any other party wishes to address any leave application filed by Miraka, they may either file a memorandum with the Council's Independent Hearings Coordinator within 3 working days of that leave application being provided to the parties and/or on the WRC website, or appear at the Hearing at 9.00 am on 6 August 2019".

Any party that wishes to address Miraka's memorandum may file a memorandum with the Council's Independent Hearings Coordinator no later than **5.00 pm on the 5 August 2019**, or appear at the hearing at **9.00 am on 6 August 2019**. Any party wishing to appear at the hearing must advise the Council's Independent Hearings Coordinator of this not later than **5.00 pm on the 5 August 2019**.
