My name is Richard Hull and we farm as Clover Farms Ltd in the Lower Waikato River catchment. The property has been farmed by our family since the 1800's and by the current generation since the 1970's. At present we run beef and grow kiwifruit on the property as well as having planted forestry on the more marginal land. Over the past 40 years the property has been used for dairying, market gardening, and intensive poultry production.

	It is unreasonable to rule out future food production on good quality market gardening land by imposing an arbitrary date when it has been used for vegetable production in the past and should be available in the future.	
	It is in fact inequitable and unreasonable to rule out any future land use based on what it may or may not have been used for on a given date. This is particularly inequitable when other properties within the region, with no smaller footprint, are permitted to operate.	
	It affects the value of our land and impedes any future ability to develop and grow our kiwifruit business. It also affects our ability to market our land in the future as suitable for dairying, market gardening, or orchard production. This effectively removes huge amounts of equity, due to drop in land value.
