MY SUBMISSION IS THAT

A- We oppose requirements to obtain consents for cultivation of land on slopes greater than 15 degrees, and for winter forage crops fed in-situ on these land classes. We do not believe that our farm management decisions should be interfered with by a bureaucratic process which will cost us money for administration. Council officers are not farmers, and most have little understanding of the agricultural science behind contemporary farm management practices. We do not agree with the "Consent to farm" approach. B- We believe that the proposal for 'grand parenting' existing nitrogen application/outputs for each property is a flawed mechanism. It rewards existing high fertiliser N 'appliers' with a high NRP, while those who currently use small amounts of strategic fertiliser N applications will end up with a low NRP. This results in WRC picking winners and losers - those with a low NRP that wish to increase N usage in future will not be able to do so. This instantly devalues their land for resale and land-use change/intensification potential. Meanwhile, those with a high NRP will be able to continue applying N at an unsustainable rate. This continued high application rate and NRP allocation disparity is not healthy for the catchments involved, nor for local community relationships. It sets intensive farmers against extensive farmers, and the outcome is continued pollution. Plus theft of future land value from those with a low NRP by the WRC. We believe that WRC should base the NRP for each property on what the specific catchment can cope with and deliver in terms of meeting thresholds for healthy river key indicators. This will depend on the specific characteristics of each sub-catchment/catchment and include geological/soil/climate and all relevant environmental factors. The PC1 proposed NRP model is inequitable. C- We support the use of Farm Environment Plans, BUT prepared by the landowner. We have a history of this. D- We support stock exclusion where appropriate. But believe that should not include ephemeral stream channels/swampy areas. We have done 20 years of planting and riparian retirement works on our farm already.
