3.11.5.1 2) & Schedule C iii requires any wetland to be fenced. The definition of wetland is unclear and not well defined. For example we have a small 'pond' which appears to be a constructed wetland, but this is only wet for a few months of the year and does not "support a natural ecosystem of plants and animals that are adapted to wet conditions". As such, it is unreasonable to have our 'pond' to fall under the fencing provision.

Schedule A suggests that all properties will be registered with Council. As landowners we are currently registered with Waikato District Council and Waikato Regional Council as ratepayers, and the title of our property indicates the size of land we own. Additionally, as stock owners, we are registered with NAIT and AHB. This adds another registration to our list, which seems unnecessary.

- **3.11.5.2 4) c)** excludes grazing or cultivation land with a slope greater than 15 degrees from the rule. This slope is considered very minor, and there is no minimum size limit of areas with slopes greater than this. This would mean that any property, under this rule, with any slope of 15 degrees for even a very small area would require a FEP.
- **3.11.5.1 5)** limits stocking rate to less than 6 stock units per hectare. A list of stock unit numbers by animal is given which seems to over-estimate the stock units in some situations. The science behind this does not appear robust and is somewhat arbitrary. For example, the 6000 megajoules of metabolisable energy per year does not equate to the listed stock units per animal in all cases. For reference, on our property of 2.12Ha has been stocked at 44 stock units without external feed and with zero nitrogen fertiliser added.

3.11.5.1 2) & Schedule C iii. Define wetlands and exclude insignificant temporary wetlands.

Schedule A Exclude all properties less than 50Ha unless the property is known to be carrying out activities which are deemed beyond the permitted activities. Also suggest that a unified register be established to encourage land owners to register by making everything available in one place.

3.11.5.2 4) c) Better definition and size limits of slopes are required. The slope limit should also be increased to 30 degrees.

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3.11.5.1 5) Liaise with industry and landowners, undertake more thorough research into stocking units for animal categories, and increase the stock unit rate accordingly to suit land types.
