1. I strongly oppose the above provisions because the requirement to establish a Nitrogen Reference Point based on one of two financial years (either 2014/15 or 2015/16) is an arbitrary means of calculating an acceptable level of application.
2. It is too simple a process to select two years that could genuinely be representative of(a) historic levels of application(b) future/steady-state/typical levels of application.
3. Furthermore, the two seasons able to be used to establish a Nitrogen Reference Point are not indicative of typical levels for our farming operation. This was due to both climatic and economic factors.

This does not mean to suggest that we as members of the rural community should not commit to drive change in water quality, but eather both urban and rural members should equally commit to this change. • I am strongly opposed to the overall approach to set region-wide rules and a potentially expensive model that would be required to police such an approach. I believe that a more pragmatic approach (and one that would enable a better use of tax payers funds) would be to investigate the region on a sub-catchment by sub-catchment basis. That would mean that the areas that require the biggest amount of focus (and would drive the biggest amount of change) could be investigated and improved first.
