# 1. About Us:

We own 490 Hectares of medium hill country in the upper catchment headwaters west of lake Whangapae in Plan Change 1 - Prioirty 1 area 16.

Our 490 Ha supports our three families (7 adults and 7 children).

The farm has been developed and added to over three generations spanning 70 years. We farm 6000+ Stock Units made up of cattle and dairy grazers and sheep on the steeper country. We are environmentally proactive and are progressively fencing off bush remnants, planting woodlots etc. We enjoy sharing our asset with visiting groups and the general public. In the future we plan to continue to improve pasture and maintain a sustainable farming operation as well as enhancing our natural environments: - bush remnants and unique features.

Our three families enjoy a very modest income and enjoy the lifestyle our land provides.

#### 2. Concerns:

- a. I applaud that in section 3.11.1.2 page 25 Plan Change 1 acknowledges the significance of primary production for the Waikato region. Yet the plan as outlined has real potential to destroy or severly curtail these same significant Primary Industries.
- b. I am concerned that Plan Change 1 has potential, with its huge cost of implementation and compliance, to make our farm uneconomic. This will subsequently have grave impact on our local community flowing on to the wider community. Eg. Six children from our family attend our local schools and our family members provide leadership in school, preschool groups, tennis club and several community support groups, as well as leadership in groups in the wider community.
- c. I don't believe that the Plan Change 1 addresses the issues that are the primary cause of the Lower Waikato lakes degradation.
- d. I support the submission that has been lodged by Federated Farmers
  - The significant negative effect on rural communities
  - The cost and practicality of the rules
  - The effect that the Nitrogen Reference Point will have on my business and my economic wellbeing
  - The Farm Environment Plan requirements leading to unnecessary and costly regulation of inputs, outputs, normal farming activity and business information
  - The cost and practicality of the rules and requirements for stock exclusion, the Nirtrogen Reference Point and the Farm Environmental Plan
  - The timeframes for complying with the Nitrogen Reference Point rules which are too short and unachievable
  - The plan significantly exceeding the 10 year targets in many attributes and areas
  - The lack of science and monitoring at the sub catchments level.

I set out my concerns more specifically below.

37	3.11.4.5 Sub catchment Scale Planning	Support	I strongly encourage the development of sub catchment scale plans. I recommend that an ammendment be included to a holistic approach with particular reference to Koi Carp.
33	Policy 9 Sub Catchment	Support	Sub Catchment planning needs to comply with the Regional Policy Statement.
40	3.11.5.2 Permitted Activity Rule	Oppose	Our headwaters all above 25° contain large areas of swamp land that are impossible to fence for stock exclusion. The swamps act as a mitigating factor and act as a filter sponge for run off.
40	3.11.5.2(4) Permitted Activity Rule	Oppose	To limit our enterprise to cultivating slopes under 15° would severly limit our ability to recontour and regrass much of our farm. Much of our land has 50 to 100 meters of "Buffer Slope" before any swamp or water body.
42	3.11.5.4 Controlled Activities	Oppose	Any reduction in our already wise use of fertilizer would reduce our production and make our farm uneconomic. Our use of N is limited to 1-2 tonne a year over 490 Ha.
45	3.11.5.7 Land Use Change	Oppose	These restrictions reduce our ability to respond to changes in market conditions or technological advances in the future that could keep our enterprise viable.
47 & 53	Schedule B Nitrogen Reference Point etc Schedule 1.5 A&B	Oppose Remove & Delete	There is a large body of science that supports the fact that this Nitrogen Reference Point produces no benefit. The cost of this proposal to our operation in time and finance is huge. We object and oppose the huge invasion of privacy around Schedule B.
63	Table on page 63 (Whangapae Stm Rangiriri – Glen Murray Rd) clearly indicates that our catchment already meets the 80 year Target for Nitrogen.		

# **General Points**

# KOI CARP

I have observed Lake Whangapae for 60+ years. In spite of Plan Change 1 seeking to clean it up, I believe little will improve until there is an acknowledgement of the impact of Koi Carp on lake quality.

Carp eat all oxygen weed and churn up the lake bed and erode the banks of the lake and adjacent streams.

Whatever we do in our upper catchment – that is already clean and swimmable – will have little impacet on lake quality unless the contribution of Koi Carp is addressed as a major cause of lake degradation.

I implore you to acknowledge the extreme negative impact Koi Carp are having on the quality of our Lower Waikato lakes and tributaries.

2. It would be more prudent to remove the need for Nitrogen Reference Point (Schedule B) and replace it with a plan to implement control measures for Koi Carp.
