Introduction and Summary for Healthy Rivers Plan Change 1

Ian and Lin MacLachlan- we are brothers who farm in priority 1 catchment [Waipa] and we both also farm separately in the Western Catchment area [covered in other submissions]. Our family has owned this 265 Ha property for 96 years, and the fourth generation is now involved in the management. Our parents ashes are interred on the farm.

We are drystock beef and dairy support farmers. The farm is heavy clay/ mudstone/ pap soil which moves, this necessitates set stocking low numbers of cattle in winter months. Water reticulation [80%], slip reducing plantings, and fenced bluffs [below and above] mitigate this problem but dont solve it. Our fertilizer application is conservative and biennial, there is no cropping, break feeding or supplementary feeding. Areas of native bush are preserved. On the steeper country where there no troughs we farm only 1 beef steer/Ha which according to Federated Farmers has no detrimental effect on water quality. Our greatest concern is that rigid stock exclusion rules and fencing may stop this farm from being an economic unit. In our view retirement of such land into forestry would be an environmental and financial step backwards.

Individual FEPs, thoughtfully written, managed and administered at the sub-catchment level would be a far more holisitic way of progressing to fulfilling the WRC vision for the Waikato and Waipa catchments.

Due to the geography of our farm the fences move, so it isnt practical to fence all areas. The National Water Accord describes water bodies from a much more workable aspect, and suggests a 15degree angle. There is nothing to indicate subsidies would be available, we conservatively estimate a cost of \$200,000. for our 200Ha [excluding already fenced off native bush and bluffs]. These costs do not support Objective 2 of the plan.
The timing is too tight for us in Priority one catchment, we would require more time. We already have reticulated water to 80% of paddocks, and our experience is that with a conservative stocking rate[and well positioned troughs] stock do not go into hill-country waterways, an observation over 50 years of farming.
In the Walpa catchment sediment is an issuewith clean drains, that have steeper sides, there is decreased flooding, and less erosion. This cant be achieved when you fence off all areas.
AMENDMENTS; change the rules to the National Water Accord, and incorporate MOE guidelines for stock exclusion
Change the timelines, and use Farm Plans to indicate progressive changes required Allow for much greater input at sub-catchment areas, Fencing is such an expensive and time consuming requirement that farms may be better treated on a case by case situation, hence support for FARM PLANS
