Forrestry is only practical for large companies that could afford thee tree trimming and maintenence required to bring grown trees to q stale were good quality Timber could be harvested Timbsey harvesting is expensive requiring heavy machinery and Labour. After cutting and removating Trees beaves a terrible mess of branchs, roading and debris which run into streams.
