INTRODUCTION

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the Waikato Regional Councils proposed Plan Change 1.

First of all I would like to say that I support the objective of improving the water quality of our rivers but feel that the changes and restrictions in PC1 will unfairly impact our farming business with excessive costs and unfair restrictions which will negatively affect futures profits and viability, and do little to alter the quality of water leaving our farm.

I believe that the issue of water qulity is a national one and needs a collaborative approach from all New Zealanders (why is it ok to pollute Raglan Harbour but not the Waikato River) also the Urban community seem to have no responsibilty on this plan.

Also from a personal perspective the biggest negative influence on water quality on our farm comes from Koi carp which doesnt seemed to mentioned anywhere. Our family have been farming this property since 1905 in my time here I have followed best management practices of the day as I want future generations to be able to farm here sustainably.
