<u>Proposed Waikato Regional Plan Change 1 – Waikato and Waipa</u> <u>River Catchments Submission</u>

My concern is the practicality of the plan. I have been farming since 1956 – 22 years were on hard Taranaki Hill Country. My family is now farming two properties, one in the plan and the other not included as yet (to my understanding). I consider it impossible to fence these waterways off on steep hills because of the contour. It has been commented that a one wire electric fence or an 8 wire battened fence would be satisfactory, however in many cases this is impossible to achieve.

My other concerns are as follows:

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- 1. What about the cost of fencing many kilometres in length
- 2. What about rabbits and control what a haven
- 3. What about stock water and the cost of new water supplies
- 4. What about weeds etc (blackberry and barberry and many others
- 5. What about the increase of rating costs to support an army of experts
- 6. Hill country profits since 1991 very marginal if any at all
- 7. Value of wool \$6 to \$7 greasy per kilo up to 1990 now \$2.80 greasy if lucky
- Value of lambs approx. \$90 prime and hill country farmers are getting \$30 - \$50 for stores
- 9. The cost of this scheme should be met by Central Government because healthy waters are being demanded by the general public throughout New Zealand
