#### MY SUBMISSION IS THAT

I agree that all properties over 2 ha should be registered and the activities carried out on them registered both agricultural and commercial operations particularly where point source discharges happen, rule 1 allows sufficient provision for smaller properties.

Rule 2 agree with the permitted activity rule.

Registration of all properties is important, the time frame should be dependent on the final implementation of the plan. Also it should have a provision for land owners to record land uses in the past 10 years as this particularly in the catchment areas land use changes have happened regularly (dairy to grazing/cropping) and particularly in relation to rule 7.

In relation to rule 3 we agree with a certified industry scheme with the following provisos that it also includes what is presently been done and the future maintainance of those improvements and are recorded in the plan. The capability and experience of those carrying out the plans and monitoring of them is critical to the success of improving the river quality. Where stock exclusion is already in place then that should be acceptable. We agree that those with a nitrogen reference point greater than the 75th percentile reduce theirs to below that threshhold and within the shorter timeframe. Once the threshhold is fixed in 2019 for each catchment that will be the figure not a rolling one going forward.

Cultivation rule needs flexability and a straight 5 m rule across all catchments is to general. Handling it in the farm plans and showing the mitigations appropriate to the catchment and soil type is the best way to handle this rule.

Rule 7 needs more flexability particularly where properties have had the had use in the past ey grazny > dany etc.
