Dear Sirs

I am in agreement with your total aim to clear water ways by 2026. I am not sure under which number some of my submission comes under except maybe 3.11.5.2

Firstly I am writing this submission because there is no way that I can fence off all the swamp areas on my farm at Lot 6 DP 359319.

I have not got the financial resources to do so and this year I am planning on spraying the gorse on my farm before it gets away on me anymore.

Part 2 of my submission is where we cannot increase the number of stock on the farm above what we had in October 2016 is unreasonable. As our stock policy could be changed to fattening cattle instead of cows, calves and bulls that I have at present.

Alternatively, I could also lease out all of my farm completely and the lease may want different classes of stock to what I have or maybe do some cropping.

I would like the opportunity to speak to my submission in the future.

In conclusion Plan Change 1 has some very complex issues that need further thorough discussion especially in the Nutrient Discharge Allowance NDA stock and fencing issues.

If farmers are allowed a fair amount of time like up to 2026 to meet some of the issues I am sure many farmers will comply longer term. THANK YOU

Footnote to go with my submission.

We have planted 2 hectares of pine trees on the farm in a canyon around 1978 and harvested in 2010. The same canyon has been replanted in 2010.

My wife has planted several varieties of native and exotic trees around our farm and I have planted a small block of Kauri trees, roughly 250. in the year 2000.

Finally of the 81.25 hectares I have left, a local contractor is leasing 25 hectares and has some of it in maize.
