There are three main streams and their tributaries and springs on this farm. The Mangarewarewa (approx 1.85km); the Mangati (1.75km) and the The Tahi (2 km). As seen on the farm map theses streams run through bush (the best soil reticulation) and grassland. The length of the farm heading downstream to the Waipa.

If all the stream swere fenced eith er side it would include 11.5 km of fence.Am I compensated for losss of land? Fencing thru bush is difficult because of the roots,etc. And this would do damaged to trees if fenced too close.

The property mainly runs sheep. Sheep DON'T stand in water and DON'T like wet feet. Front easy paddocks are troughed but back hills not. Up until a few years ago our house water came straight from the Mangarewarewa stream until the iron content cause problems.

In recent years a subdivision is been developed bordering our top /western boundary fence. From 9 to 13 sections as indicated on the Map GERYHA subdivision. Five of these sections smaller sizes than 2 hecs who border on the above streams will, have no regulaton at all. So while their sewerage seeps down the hillsides into the springs we the nextdoor farmer pays the price!

Also on the lower part of Te Tahi Rd another subdivision has developed right on the same Mangarewarewa stream. From your map information 4 or 5 of these sections that also border the stream will not be included and yet their household sewerage drains onto this same stream. One household I believe has a worm farm – no sewerage. A good example of uran verses rural in a rural environment!
