Introduction

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the Waikato Regional Councils proposed Plan Change 1.

We are Helen and Neil Potter, and we run a 50/50 sheep and cattle farm on 257 ha in the priority 1&2 catchments.

This farm has been in the family for just under 60 years. My father put approximately 40 ha of native bush into a Queen Elizabeth covenant in the 1970's, 35 ha of which leads down to the Waipa River. We also have approximately 100 ha made up of several blocks of native bush and regeneration. On the more sensitive areas of the farm, we have planted smaller blocks of pines and exotic trees.

Our farm, situated in the Rangitoto district 16 km's east of Te Kuiti, comprises of 2/3's good contour and 1/3 steeper country. The easier land could be converted to dairy although we have never wanted to. We have two dairy farms on either side of us.

For the last 20 years we have supplied several organic butchers in Auckland with a year round supply of organic beef and lamb.
