While appreciating and understanding the need for some farming operations to make managerial and land use changes protect our catchments and water ways to improve water quality, the proposed plan does not adequately or fairly enable this.

<u>Urban centres have significant impact on water quality. The plan needs to place demand for change equitably</u> between rural and urban in proportion to the degree of contamination from rural and urban sources.

Many farmers have already taken action, made investment to do so (protecting water ways, reducing nutrient inputs, effluent systems, grazing, cropping and forage harvesting methods, efforts to reduce contaminant losses). Their past effort need to be recognised and provided for so as to not disadvantage future land use potential and profit in addition to expense and profit their past "eco-friendly" farm choices have incurred/foregone.

We are dairy goat as well as dairy cow farmers. Our farming methods and impact on water ways is significantly different to other pastoral enterprises and need to be consider and accommodated for differently.

Overseer is limited and unable to accurately model traditional dairy farms. It is not set up to model goat farms, in particular the effects of cut and carry, the use of wood chip bedding in barns, the subsequent benefit of its high carbon content to soil biology, organic matter and reduction of N loss among other things. I am concerned Overseers limitations will adversely impact on my farming options, farm profit and ultimately constrain wealth creation.

As a large part of our property is assigned to providing forage to housed goats, fencing requirements potentially limit our effective farming area and therefore scale. The plan needs to be modified to clearly ensure stock exclusion requirements only relate to cows, horses, pig & deer.

Soil types differ widely across the region. Restrictions on land use due to gradient, in-situ grazing of winter forage crops and cultivation that are necessary for one soil type may be completely inappropriate for another. Restrictions need to be soil type specific.

The plan demands urban centres clean up their act to the same degree demanded of farmers.
Adequate assessment of previous efforts of farmers to improve water quality must be allowed for where future restrictions are to be imposed.
The unique management systems of goat farming and their low impact on water quality need to be acknowledged and considered separately.
Until it can completely, comprehensively and accurately model all farm systems, Overseer will not be used to restrict farm practices.
