I would like to draw attention to the fact that since the close date for these submissions we have experienced the threat of two more major tropical cyclones named Debbie and Cook, the likes of which frequently effect the North Island bringing extreme weather conditions particularly to these Coromandel Ranges /Waikato. Even though the main onslaught of these last two weather events missed the region, they caused vast devastation that will take months to restore at massive costs to the area.

As referred to in my submission we have experienced such events when they have made landfall in entirety and indeed many of them over my lifetime.

WRC regulatory policies must reflect the extent to which natural phenomena govern hill country and take into account the extensive measures most hill country farm operators have put in place in recognition of this.

Extra consideration should be given to the impracticality of Fencing, providing Supplementary Water Supplies and
Stock Crossing Structures along water bodies on land with a 15 degree slope or land between 15 and 25 degree slope
and with a stocking rate of 6 stock units. Land in this category is often less accessible making it very expensive for such construction to be carried out.
From my own experience these structures are all impermanent. A little over two years ago kilometres of 'Clean
Streams' fencing was swept away in an extreme weather event. Ref. June 2014 North Western Coromandel Flood.
Also there is a strong demand through District Council Plans being put in place at present not to have structures
including the likes of fences and water tanks or earthworks interrupting the experiential attributes of the rural scene.
