Rule3.11.5.2 point 3bi re stocking rates.

As the owner of a small horse stud, the stocking rates as they apply to horses are onerous. Horse numbers in a horse business are by nature extremely variable and changes rapidly depending on time of year (foals or not), ability to sell or not (market conditions), the number of outside mares coming to a stallion in a season which in variable and unpredictable and the mares may or may not have foals at foot and may stay for extended times depending on if they are in foal or not. So the base number may be x but may change significantly over the course of a year and year to year. Horses are frequently stabled which reduces land impact significantly and there is no acknowledgement of or allowance for this in the plan. Horses (sport and pleasure not racing) are not a high profit enterprise but are a significant contributor to the Waikato economy. This tight control over stocking rates will impact on people needing to graze horses who do not own land, and will adversely effect small breeders such as myself.

small horse businesses contribute to the Waikato economy. They are however unlikely to generate significant income for their owners. There is significant year to year and month to month variation in stocking rates and there is not provision for this in the plan- as the base may be significantly lower than what a stud might have post foaling and during sales prep.

Horses are often kept stabled which reduces impacts on land, and this is also not taken into consideration.

Furthermore, a large number of people rely on rented grazing to keep their horses on. This plan is likely to significantly effect the cost and availability of grazing and impact the job and recreational opportunities of a reasonable number of people for whom horse riding is a large part of their business and lifestyle.
