Background

Miraka is a recently established independent Whole Milk Powder processor, having completed 4 successful seasons, processing raw milk from 98 farms within an 85km radius of Mokai

It is the first majority Maori owned dairy processing facility in the world

The factory has an 8mt GEA dryer with the capability of producing high quality Whole Milk Powder, and a new 100,000 litres/d UHT milk plant with the capability to expand


Water quality and use form a key driver for our focus on improving our environmental footprint.

Framework

Te Ara Miraka will contain mandatory and incentivised criteria that will be independently reviewed annually from the 2017 season.

The programme is designed to meet overseas customer demands for a responsible food origin. Sales leveraged from the value of this programme are expected to bring a premium. This premium will then incentivise the continuation of Te Ara Miraka; further developing on-farm production efficiency and sustainability.
