Revision of project timeline

 Notification date set at the project outset with a view to revising if needed once project underway

- Delays in establishing project architecture
 - Interim CSG Chairperson, thorough process given project infancy
 - TLG Group, securing appropriate selection panel resource
- Need to respond to concerns expressed by TLG, CSG, and Iwi partners



Revision of project timeline

- Still an imperative to expedite as soon as possible
- Sectors have bought into a process that has a finite life, implications for extending need consideration
- National and regional multi-sector visibility of the project, need to maintain project credibility
- Awareness of risks associated with revised timetable for notification

November CSG

- "TLG information and modelling, CSG need the time to do the work"
- "Allow the public opportunity to consider and respond"

December CSG

- "No serious consideration been given to timeline"
- "Concerns are timeframes and working with TLG/TRH"
- "Squeeze if keep to proposed timeframe"
- "Need time to reflect back to our own sectors"




Process for timeline amendment

- Project management framework
- Connection to Annual Plan and CEO KPI's set by Council

- TRH discussion to respond to concerns of TLG and CSG – what does this mean for the project?
- CSG consider the revised project timeline
- Need for CSG to feed back into HRWO Committee
- HRWO Committee inform a Council resolution
