## Wainui Farm Park

- Whaingaroa Harbour Care encouraged the Wainui Farm Park committee to retire about 1/3 of the farm from grazing.
- Despite retiring and planting gullies, wet areas and steep parts of the farm, the farm now runs double the number of cattle.

## Wainui Farm Park

- The farm park manager can now concentrate on the productive areas, spending less time on weed control and less dollars on fertiliser.
- Environmental improvements have led to economic benefits.










## Waireinga/Bridal Veil Falls

- 15 km fenced
- 27.8 ha retired
- Due to the enthusiasm of the neighbouring landowners, they retired a much larger area than expected and a total to 114,333 native trees were planted.
